The operator reported that the line on 482 was completed but now we were having some leaks in other spots where there's still old line.

The only old business to be discussed was the improvement plan and the American Rescue Act portal and that the engineer was sending us requests for the things they need for that.

The board discussed the rate increase from Sabine Water and the financials and what we could afford to pay to get the back pay caught up and decided upon 5 payments over 5 months.

Robert made a motion to pay Sabine Water 5 payments of \$26,078.75 over 5 months to pay off the back debt owed due to their abominable bookkeeping issues and office staff issues they went through the past year. Danny seconded the motion. All were in favor. Motion passes.
